Class Sunscreen Notice & Sun Safe Practices

Dear Families,

Too much UV can cause sunburn, skin and eye damage and skin cancer. Overexposure to UV during childhood and adolescence is a major factor for future skin cancer risk.

You can't see or feel the sun's UV so don't be fooled. Whatever the weather, if the UV levels are three or more, it's important to Slip, Slop, Slap and Seek!

Our school aims to protect children and staff from too much UV, to help minimise future skin cancer risk. During the daily local sun protection times (issued whenever UV levels are three and above), students will need to:

Slip on SPF 30 (or higher) broadspectrum, water-resistant sunscreen – apply a generous amount of sunscreen at the start of the day and make sure children have sunscreen in their bag ready to be reapplied throughout the day. Sunscreen should be reapplied every two hours. Please ensure they get plenty of sunscreen application practice at home so they will be all set when they are at school.

The school will also be supplying sunscreen in each year group area. The contents of the supplied sunscreen are below, and we ask you to please inform us, using the return slip, if your child has any allergic reactions to this brand of sunscreen.

Slap on a hat – The school encourages students to wear the bucket style hat. It is important to remember that peak caps do not offer as much protection as our bucket style hat. Please help your child remember to bring and wear their approved school hat.

Seek shade – choose shady spots for play whenever possible.

Each day our Environment Leaders will update the class UV Chart with the UV rating for the day. This will help remind the students about the importance of sun safe practices and alert them to the levels of UV predicted.
