Athletics Carnival – Friday July 6

Dear Parents/Carers

This year our Athletics Carnival will be held on Friday, July 6, at Glenbrook Oval. The carnival will begin at 9:15am, with our first whole school events commencing at 9:30am.

The day will consist of a variety of track and field events, including novelty events that all children will be able to participate in. The track and field events will provide students with the opportunity to gain selection to the Zone Carnival for children 8 years and older.

The carnival events will be run in age groups and all children are encouraged to participate in all track events, novelty events and the long jump. Children who wish to participate in the shot put and discus field events will need to register their interest before the day. Additionally, children who wish to run in the 800m events will need to make their own way to the venue for an 8am start. This will conclude at 8:30 with parents/carers required to take their child back to school for the morning attendance roll.

For the day to be successful and enjoyable, we will require the assistance of our community. Parents/carers will be required to assist with the running of our novelty events (with teacher assistance), recording and the timing of our track events and field events. If you are able to assist on the day, can you please complete the parent/carer helper from attached to this note.

What students will need to bring on the day

- Food for recess and lunch.
- Water bottle.
- Sunscreen
- School hat
- School sports uniform. Students that have a shirt/jumper in the colour of their House are asked to wear this instead of their sports shirt. If students wish to dress up in items that represent their house colour, they may.

Finally, the carnival will conclude at approximately 2:45, with the children making their way back to school for normal dismissal.
