Stage 3 Camp Information

Dear Parents,

As you are aware, our overnight excursion to Vision Valley is fast approaching on *Thursday 14th June and Friday 15th June* in Week 7. The students and teachers are very excited. To make sure that final preparations are in order, please read through the following important information.

The teachers accompanying the children to Vision Valley will be Mrs Maunder, Mrs Brown, Mrs Robinson and Mr Ticehurst.

Thursday 14th June

Students need to arrive at school by 8.00am.

Friday 15th June

Students will return back to school by 3.30pm.

<u>What to bring</u>

All items MUST be clearly labelled with your child's name and packed into an soft bag that your child can carry. Students are responsible for all of their own items.

LINEN

- Sleeping bag.
- Pillow and a pillow case.
- Towel.

MEDICINE

- Children who are currently on any medication, including seasonal asthma sufferers who do not have an asthma plan at school, must provide the class teacher with their child's medication on the day of departure, in the original container with the following details clearly marked:
 - Student's Name
 - Name of Medication
 - Dosage
 - Time and frequency of administration
 - Name of prescribing doctor
- All medicine that is stored in the school office will be brought with the teachers and administered as per the school medical plan.



CLOTHING

- Wear Mufti clothes to school on Thursday, with enclosed shoes.
- Mufti clothes to wear on Friday, with enclosed shoes.
- Socks and underwear.
- Warm pyjamas.
- Jacket or jumper.
- Plastic bag for dirty laundry.

TOILETRIES

- Soap.
- Toothbrush and Toothpaste.
- Roll on deodorant (no spray bottles).
- Comb and/ or brush and hair ties for girls.
- Sunscreen.

OPTIONAL ITEMS

- Winter hat/beanie, for the evening.
- Scarf, gloves, to wear in the evening.
- Digital camera.
- Disco outfit for Thursday night.

The following items are not permitted

- Mobile phones, ipods, ipads or other electronic equipment eg. DS console
- Money: There is no shop at the campsite.
